In the event of injury or illness, whether physical, mental or dental, which requires the attention of a doctor, we consent to any reasonable medical treatment or hospitalization as deemed necessary by a licensed physician, school nurse, and/or appropriate medical or clinic personnel. In the event neither parent can be reached in an emergency situation, I/we hereby authorize the WAnet/SEI and Wheaton Academy officials to give legal consent for any medical treatment, procedure and/or hospitalization while attempting to reach parent. I/we agree to hold such persons harmless and free of any legal responsibility: of any claims, demands, or suit for damages arising from this action. I understand that if medical treatment is for an illness and not a school-related accident, I will be responsible to pay the medical costs if it is not covered by the international student insurance. (Pre-existing conditions will not be covered by student insurance. Any medical costs incurred treating pre-existing conditions will be the responsibility of the parent.)

We further consent to any routine medical treatments, immunizations, or annual physical exams deemed necessary by a licensed physician, Wheaton Academy, or the student's host parents. I/we agree to hold the student's host parents, and such persons representing Wheaton Academy harmless and free of any legal responsibility: of any claims, demands, or suit for damages that arise from this action. Parent / Legal Guardians Agreement, Indemnification & Liability Release

I/we attest that the Student is of good health and character, understands the important role of a WAnet/SEI/Wheaton Academy boarding student, and will, to the best of his/her ability, maintain the high standards required of a WAnet, should he/she be chosen to represent his/her family, school, community, state/province, and country. We further state that all the information provided in this application and the attached documents is true and accurate to the best of our knowledge.

1. **No Refund.** We recognize that no refunds will be available **unless** WAnet initiates decides to cancel the trip.

2. **Rules and Regulations.** By signing below, I/we hereby state that I/we have thoroughly read the WAnet/CONNECT Guidelines and agree that the Student will abide by the Guidelines during his or her time at WAnet. I/we hereby state that we have read and understood the Guidelines and agree to be bound by them. The Guidelines are important parts of this Agreement. WAnet has the right to dismiss or require the withdrawal of any student whenever, in the exercise of WAnet's professional judgment, it may be appropriate to do so, including as a result of conduct contrary to its rules or regulations (such as conduct that violates the standards contained in the Guidelines), behavior unsafe to self or others, or academic performance inconsistent with the standards contained in the Student Guidelines. I/we also understand that the Student will be subject to the authority of the WAnet/CONNECT personnel and that the Student will have to follow the rules given by WAnet/CONNECT staff.

3. **Indemnification.** In consideration of the acceptance to and participation of the Student in the Program, I/we, the parents/legal guardians of the Student, to the fullest extent permitted by law, hereby agree to defend (with counsel reasonably acceptable to WAnet, hold harmless, and indemnify WAnet, and their respective employees, agents, trustees, officers, and directors (collectively, the "Indemnified Parties"), from and against any and all claims, losses, damages, liabilities, and expenses (including settlement costs and any reasonable legal or other expenses for investigating or defending any actions or threatened actions) the Indemnified Parties may incur in connection with any action, claim, or dispute arising out of the Student's participation in the Program or use of WAnet facilities.

4. **Waiver of Claims.** I/we hereby expressly waive and renounce any claims against all host parents and members of their families, WAnet, and any of their respective employees, agents, trustees, officers, and directors, for any and all damages, actions, causes of action, liabilities, claims or demands whatsoever, including without limitation, any claims or damages resulting from injury to property or person, including death, which I/we may ever have, arising out of the Student's participation in the Program, including any such liability that may arise out of any negligent act or omission, excepting gross negligence or intentional conduct, of any such persons or entities, which the Student may ever have, arising out of the Student's participation in the Program, including travel to and from the host country.

5. **Covenant Not to Sue.** I/we agree that I/we shall never institute or cause to be instituted, any suit, charge, demand, claim, complaint, or cause of action, in law, in equity, or otherwise, in any court, or in any arbitration system or procedure, against WAnet, arising out of the Student's participation in the Program or use of WAnet facilities.

6. **Acknowledgement.** I/we expressly agree that the foregoing indemnification, waiver of claims, and covenant not to sue, (collectively, this "Waiver") is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by the laws of the state of Illinois and that if any portion hereof is deemed invalid or enforceable by a Court of competent jurisdiction, the invalid or unenforceable portion of this Waiver shall be deleted or deemed modified to the extent necessary to be deemed valid or enforceable and the balance of the Waiver shall continue in full force and effect.

7. **Miscellaneous.** This Parent/Legal Guardians Agreement, Indemnification and Liability Release: (a) shall bind and inure to the benefit of myself and my heirs, executors, administrators, legal representatives, successors and assigns; (b) constitutes the entire agreement between the parties hereto with respect to the subject matter hereof; and (c) may not be amended or modified, nor any provision hereof waived, except in a writing signed by all of the parties hereto; and (d) shall be governed in accordance with the internal laws of the state of Illinois.

Guidelines for CONNECT Participants

Behavioral Expectations

- The student will obey the disciplinary rules of WAnet/CONNECT and will be respectful of trip staff. Repeated disobedience or disrespect will not be tolerated and may be grounds for discipline, up to and including, being dismissed from the trip without refund.
- The student understands that any expectations of the school that the student currently attends carry over to the CONNECT Trips.
- Students are expected to be on-time to all scheduled trip activities and check-in points. Repeated timeliness issues may result in disciplinary action.
- Students are expected to dress modestly. Students with questions should seek guidance from their host parents or school administrator. Students may be required to purchase new clothes at their own cost.
- The student's parents give WAnet/CONNECT the right to use the student's photograph, tape recording or livestream filming for reproduction in any medium for the purposes of publication, advertising, marketing, display, or editorial use. Information such as the student's name, activity, and class may also be communicated.
- Students must comply with all applicable laws of the United States including all applicable federal and state laws, and municipal ordinances. A Student who is cited for a municipal ordinance violation may be disciplined, up to and including expulsion, in the sole discretion of WAnet.
- The student is not allowed to possess or use illegal drugs, or to misuse prescriptive medication. Smoking and the use of any tobacco products is forbidden. The drinking of any alcoholic beverages is expressly forbidden. United States law strictly forbids the consumption of alcohol for everyone under age 21.

Trip Eligibility

- Students must in good academic and behavioral standing with their host school in order to be eligible for this trip. All participants must seek permission to participate in a trip from their **parents, host parents, and international boarding director.**

Financial Matters

- The CONNECT Trip must be paid-in-full at the time of registration. Payment plans are not available and all payments must be made online using the online registration form. Please note that most international credit cards are accepted using the online payment system.
- Students are encouraged to bring their own spending money. WAnet/CONNECT will not assume responsibility for any lost or stolen personal property or money.
- Rooming and most meals are covered under the trip expenses. Flight/transportation costs to and from the CONNECT Trip are not included in the trip cost. The cost of transportation is the responsibility of the student/family.
- The only time a **refund** will be issued is in the event that the trip organizers (WAnet/CONNECT) have to cancel the trip. There are no other exceptions to the refund policy.

Communication

- Students should be **proactive** in communicating the details of this trip with parents, host parents, and international boarding director. The international boarding director will receive a copy of the trip itinerary, but it remains the responsibility of the student to coordinate communication
- Students should regularly check their provided e-mail in case additional information is necessary for the trip organizers.

Booking Travel

- Parents are responsible for booking and purchasing all flight tickets to, from, and within the United States for their Child. Once flight tickets to the United States have been purchased, Parents must forward a copy of the itinerary to the Director of International Students immediately so transportation from the airport to campus may be arranged in a mutually agreeable manner.
- Students may not arrive to a CONNECT TRIP prior to the arrival options specified in the trip registration. Parents of returning Students should not book or purchase flight tickets between the home country and the United States for school year 2016 - 2017 until re-enrollment contracts for school year 2016 - 2017 have been executed.

Medical

- All medical conditions must be disclosed on the attached waiver forms. Students are responsible for bringing and taking their own personal medicine. Students are also responsible for **carrying a personal insurance card** for the entirety of the trip. Students should ask their International Boarding Director in order to obtain a copy of their personal insurance card.

Packing

- Students will receive a packing list approximately two weeks prior to the start date of the trip. Students are encouraged to bring their cell phones. All personal items are the responsibility of the student.

Termination

- WAnet/CONNECT maintains the right to cancel the registration of any student for any reason.
